Board Meeting held 28th January 2021

# **1. FINANCE.**

The Net Loss for the month of December 2020 was \$63,250. The YTD Net Surplus is \$684,839. This is \$103,529 over budget. The December figures were severely impacted by the closure of the Course and Clubhouse.

## 2. PRACTICE NETS.

The board has agreed to an additional path from the emergency exit gate to the 9<sup>th</sup> fairway. Details of the work will be finalised shortly and is expected to be constructed in March.
