### 1. FINANCE

The Net Profit for January was \$132,509. The Net Profit for the year to date is \$592,254. It is hoped that with COVID restrictions easing that trade will return to near normal. However with the current rain event both golf and Clubhouse trade for the months of February and March will be severely impacted.

### 2. COVID RESTRICTIONS

From the 18 February there are no longer any COVID restrictions. The NSW Government is continuing to encourage masks in indoor settings where social distancing cannot be maintained.

### 3. BOARD APPOINTMENT

There have been further delays with contractor shortages and weather. It is anticipated that the work will be completed this month.

### 6. BUNKER MASTER PLAN

### 7. GOLF COURSE IRRIGATION WIRING

The Board approved to replace the irrigation wiring at a cost of \$125,150 plus GST. The project is expected to commence May this year.
